NAVY COVID-19 UPDATE

April 22, 2020

Key Developments

- As of today, 99% of USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN 71) crewmembers have been tested for COVID-19, with 777 total positive and 3,919 negative results. Of the total positive cases, 63 Sailors have recovered. 4,196 Sailors have moved ashore.
- Six Sailors assigned to USS Theodore Roosevelt are in U.S. Naval Hospital Guam being treated for COVID-19 symptoms. None of the Sailors hospitalized for COVID-19 are in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU).
- On April 19, 2020, a Department of the Navy civilian employee assigned to Personnel Support Detachment Oceana, died at the Naval Medical Center Portsmouth. The apparent cause of death was from complications associated with the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- On April 21, 2020, a Department of the Navy civilian employee assigned to Washington Navy Yard died at George Washington University Hospital. The apparent cause of death was from complications associated with the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).
